TRANSPORTATION FROM AIRPORT TO SYNTAGMA (CITY CENTER)

By bus

For Syntagma (City Center) you should take the bus E95 from the Athens International Airport "Eleftherios Venizelos". The bus departs from the area located at the inner curbside of the Arrivals Level, right outside the Intra Schengen area, between Doors 4-5 and reaches Syntagma Square.

Estimated time: 45 min

By metro:

You take the metro from the airport* with direction to "Monastiraki" and you get off at "Syntagma" Station.

* Note: In the airport, both the metro and the suburban railway depart from the same platform.

Estimated time: 43 min

By suburban railway:

You take the suburban railway from the airport* with direction to "Athens-Larissa Station" and you get off at "Doukissis Plakentias" Station. There you take line 3 of the metro, and you get off at "Syntagma" Station.

Estimated time: 43 min

^{*} Note: In the airport, both the metro and the suburban railway depart from the same platform.

By taxi:

Taxis are available at the airport anytime.

Transportation from the Airport to the centre of Athens should cost about 20-30 euros, depending on the traffic.

Receipt

According to the Greek Legislation, taxi drivers should provide upon request a receipt for the amount paid for transportation services. The receipt should also indicate the taxi registration number and the driver's name.

Prebooked Taxis

Prebooked taxis are provided upon request and make use of the inner curb of the Arrivals Level as a staging area.

Lost items in taxis

In case of lost items in taxis, please contact, the radio taxi Service Company where taxis are registered or the central police switchboard at (+30) 210 6421616, and provide the taxi registration number and the driver's name.

TRANSPORTATION FROM SYNTAGMA (CITY CENTER) TO THE AIRPORT

By bus:

For the Athens International Airport, you take the bus E95 from Syntagma Square which will take you directly to the airport.

Estimated time: 45 min

By metro:

You take line 3 of the metro from the "Syntagma" Station with direction to "Airport".

Estimated time: 43min

By suburban railway:

You take line 3 of the metro from the "Syntagma" Station with direction to "Doukissis Plakentias" where you change to suburban railway with direction to the "Airport".

Estimated time: 43min

By taxi:

Taxis are available at Syntagma Square anytime. You will find a taxi rank right in front of Syntagma Square. Transportation to the airport will cost approximately 20-30 euros, depending on the traffic.

TRANSPORTATION FROM SYNTAGMA (CITY CENTER) TO THE PORT OF PIRAEUS

By metro:

You take line 2 from "Syntagma station" with direction to "Aghios Antonios" and you get off at "Omonia station" where you change to line 1 with direction to "Pireaus". Pireaus is the last stop of line 1 and right across from Pireaus metro station you can see the port.

Estimated time: 40 min

By taxi:

There is a taxi rank right in front of Syntagma Square. Transportation to the port of Piraeus will cost about 10-15 Euros.

TRANSPORTATION FROM PIRAEUS TO SYNTAGMA (CITY CENTER)

By metro:

You take line 1 from Piraeus with direction to "Kifissia" or "Irini" and you get off at "Omonia station" where you change to line 2 with direction to "Aghios Dimitrios". You get off at "Syntagma" Station.

Estimated time: 45 min

By taxi:

Taxis are available anytime outside the port. Transportation to the city center will cost about 10-15 Euros.

TRANSPORTATION FROM AIRPORT TO THE PORT OF PIRAEUS

By bus

For the port of Piraeus you should take the bus E96 from the Athens International Airport "Eleftherios Venizelos". The bus departs from the area located at the inner curbside of the Arrivals Level, right outside the Intra Schengen area, between Doors 4-5 and reaches Piraeus (Karaiskaki Square).

Estimated time: 50 min

By metro:

You take the metro from the airport* with direction to "Monastiraki" where you change to line 1 with direction to "Piraeus".

* Note: In the airport, both the metro and the suburban railway depart from the same platform.

Estimated time: 60 min

By suburban railway:

You take the suburban railway from the airport* with direction to "Athens-Larissa Station" and you get off at "Neratziotissa" Station. There you take line 1 of the metro with direction to "Piraeus".

* Note: In the airport, both the metro and the suburban railway depart from the same platform.

Estimated time: 60 min

By taxi:

Taxis are available at the airport anytime.

Transportation from the Airport to the port of Piraeus should cost about 20-30 euros, depending on the traffic.

TRANSPORTATION FROM THE PORT OF PIRAEUS TO THE AIRPORT

By bus

You take the bus E96 from the port (Karaiskaki Square) which will take you directly to the airport.

Estimated time: 50-60 min

By metro:

You take line 1 of the metro with direction to "Kifissia" or "Irini". At "Monastiraki" Station you change to line 3 with direction to "Airport".

Estimated time: 60 min

By suburban railway:

You take line 1 of the metro from Piraeus with direction to "Kifissia" or "Irini". At "Neratziotissa" Station you change to the suburban railway with direction to "Airport".

Estimated time: 60 min

By taxi:

Taxis are available anytime outside the port.

Transportation to the airport will cost about 20-30 euros depending on the traffic.
